## How to use your new font





To install your new TrueType Font for MS-Windows, follow these easy steps:

1. Start MS-Windows and insert the Diskette into your disk drive.
2. Open the Control Panel in the Program Manager
3. Click on the Fonts icon and choose Add.
4. Locate the Drives list. Click on it once and choose the drive that holds the diskette (usually a: or b:)
5. The font window will now display Old State House (True Type)
6. Make sure that the box Copy Fonts to Windows Directory is checked.
7. Select the font by highlighting it and click OK.
8. Restart MS-Windows

You can now use your font in any MS-Windows application that supports TrueType fonts. Should you experience difficulties, repeat all of the above steps carefully and refer to your computer/software documentation.
